Acceptances:

1: Caiterína Úaine - New Name & New Device

Vert, a pegasus segreant, in chief three horseshoes inverted Or.



2: Caiterína Úaine - New Badge


(Fieldless) A horse's head couped affronty winged Or.



3: Caitrina MacDowell - New Name

4: Delecta Diana d'Averno - New Device

Azure, on an altar argent flammant Or between three crescents argent a cup gules.



5: Dyggvi inn hvassi -New Name

6: Elric filius Thome de Rippele -New Name & New Device

Sable, a cockatrice and on a bordure argent an orle sable.



7: Helen Whitmore -New Badge

(Fieldless) A squirrel contourny argent.



8: Iðunn Úlfsdóttir - New Name

9: Isobel of York - New Name & New Device

Vert, a bell tower argent roofed gules between in chief two urchins sejant erect respectant argent.

Originally submitted as “Isabel of York,” we have changed the spelling at Kingdom to reflect the submitter’s preferred spelling.



10: Mirosława bat Zipporah of Krakow - New Name & New Device

Or, a brock proper on a chief wavy argent 3 flowers gules, centered
Or.



11: Paganus Akritas -New Device

Quarterly azure and argent, a mullet of eight points quarterly Or and gules.



Returns:

1: Abigail of Inishowen -New Device

[Field], on a pall between two birds rising respectant and a maple leaf four four-leaved clovers slipped purple.

Unfortunately, this must be returned for violation of SENA A.3.F.5, which states that “Depictions that require the careful description of the relative positions of charges, tinctures, etc. in order to produce a visual effect cannot be registered. Designs must be able to be described in standard heraldic terms to be registerable.” The green section in base is too low for a per chevron division, which would be centered along the fess line, above the lower prongs of the pall, and too high for a point pointed.



2: Caitrina MacDowell - New Device

Azure, a bend vert, overall an owl argent.

This device must be returned for violation of SENA A.3.B.4.a, which states that “Charges must have good contrast with the background on which they are placed.” While the owl has excellent contrast with the field, the bend does not.
