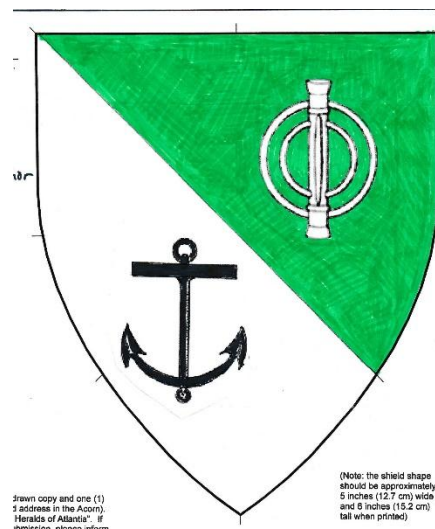

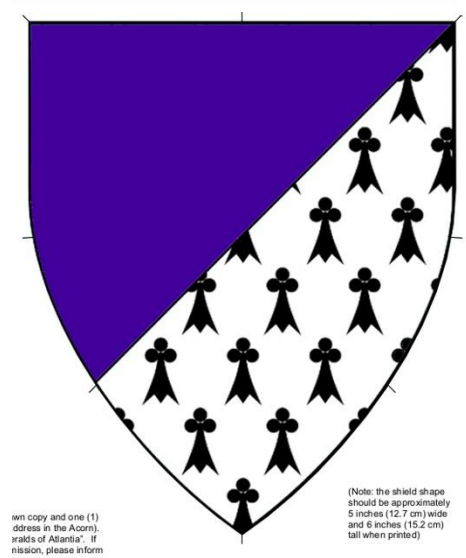

Per bend vert and argent, a punner argent and an anchor sable

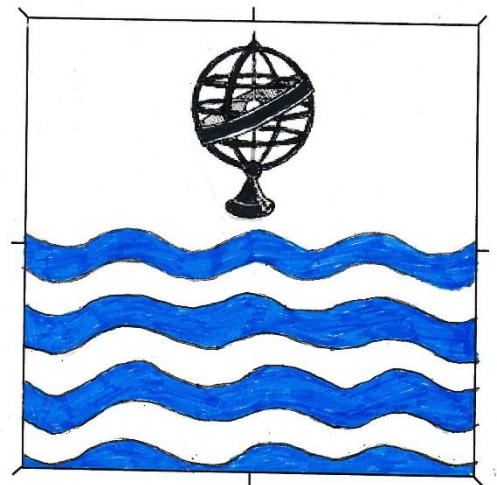


2. Baru le Bataillier – New Name

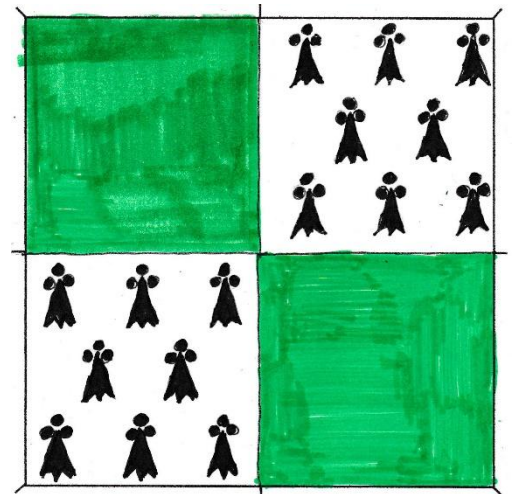
3. Caitilín inghean Uí Ruaidhrí - New Device
Per bend sinister purpure and ermine



4. Mary Taran of Glastonbury and Æduin of Skye - New Badge Change
Per fess wavy argent and barry wavy azure and argent in chief an armillary sphere sable

Quarterly vert and ermine



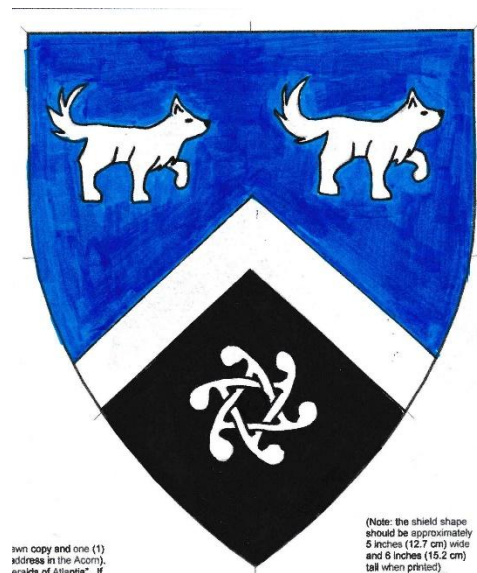

6. Vidarr Feilan - New Name

Unfortunately this name conflicts with Vikarr Feilan registered through Atenveldt in July, 2006. The two names differ by only a single interior consonant in both appearance and sound.

7. Vidarr Feilan - New Device

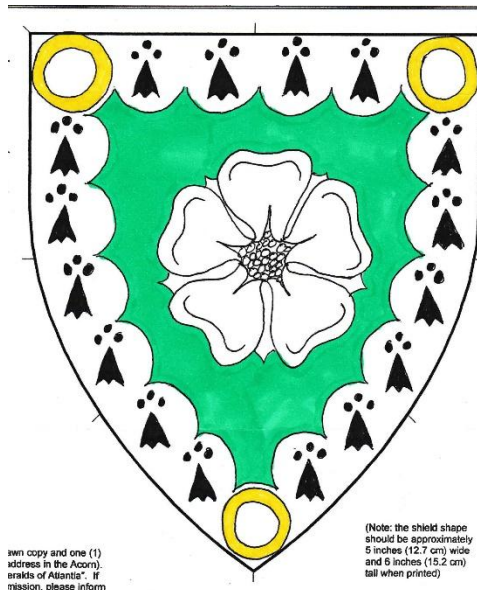
Per chevron azure and sable, a chevron between two wolves passant to sinister and a star of David argent
Unfortunately this device conflicts with Conflicts with the device of Wulfgar of East Anglia (reg. Feb 1991 via Meridies), Per chevron azure and sable, a chevron between two crosses formy fitched at the foot and a wolf's head erased close argent. There's a DC for type of secondary charge group, but nothing for orientation for the charges in chief, since the crosses in Wulfgar's device are symmetrical. It was noted that the Star of David needs to be less stylized to be recognizable as that charge.



8. Marion Compton - New Device

Vert, a rose argent, on a bordure invected ermine, three annulets Or.

This device was returned do to the annulets have poor contrast with the bordure they're on, (metal on metal). It was noted in the discussion that "It would appear that, if the annulets were changed to a tincture that offered good contrast with the ermine bordure such as vert or gules, there would at this time be no really obvious conflicts.



9. Kaaren Valravv -New Name

Unfortunately this name must be return for lack of documentation supporting the first name spelling of the double/ “aa” . The documentation supporting the name Kaaren is from Hanks and Hodges, which is on the official do not use appendix in the Administrative Handbook. The name was pended for further search documentation on the spelling, but none was found . It was noted in the discussion that Karen could be documented as usable period name.
