Submitted as Aurri la Borgne. Submitter agreed to change to reflect period correct masculine article of “le”


2. Aurri le Borgne - New Device

3. Aurri le Borgne - New Badge


*Per pale Or and azure, a salt cellar shedding salt and two hoes inverted in saltire argent.*

7. Scandal mac Rofir - New Device


*Per saltire argent and purpure, a fox rampant proper maintaining an ear of barley Or*

Submitter agreed to redraw to more clearly identify the ear of barley




8. Scandal mac Rofir - New Badge

*Per saltire argent and purpure, an ear of barley bendwise Or*




9. Seraphina Delphino - New Badge

*Argent, in bend three elephant's heads cabossed azure.*




**Returns:**

1. Scandal mac Rofir -New Badge

*Per bend sinister gules and sable, three arrows in bend sinister argent.*

Unfortunately this badge must be retuned for conflict with Loran Redbow as registered in June, 1976 ("Azure, three fire-arrows bendwise sinister in bend argent, enflamed proper.").

Only 1dc for field, we do not generally give a distinct change for relatively small enflaming such as is seen in a fire arrow.
