

Acceptances:

1. Elise Raine -New Name (see returns for device)
2. Herrad der Reiger -New Name
3. Iris Davidsdaughter -New Device: “Azure, a saltire of chain argent”



4. Julien de la Fontaine - New Alternate Name and New Badge

Alternate Name: Tahmuras al-Hajj al-Shirazi

New Badge: "Or, on a sun sable a natural leopard statant Or,
a bordure gules"



Returns:

1. Elise Raine - New Device

Sable, a dragon statant argent and in chief a mullet of ten points voided and interlaced Or.

This item must unfortunately be returned for: Mullets of more than 6 points voided and interlaced are not allowed to be secondary charges:

"Therefore, as both a default mullet, of five points, voided and interlaced and a mullet of six points voided and interlaced are easily recognizable and simple, we are hereby declaring their voiding and interlacing a part of their definition, and partially overturning the Feb 2011 precedent. That precedent will continue to apply with mullets of more than six points voided and interlaced, as being charges that are too complex [to be allowed in a non-primary charge group]". The following "fixes" have been suggested: It would appear that substituting a mullet of either five or six points for the charge in chief would resolve the stylistic issue without introducing any obvious conflicts. So that would be either:

"Sable, a dragon statant argent, in chief a mullet voided and interlaced Or."

Or "Sable, a dragon statant argent, in chief a mullet of six points voided and interlaced Or."

Alternatively, if what the submitter is going for is a solar effect, an ordinary sun could be substituted.
