Unto Eldred Triton, Roderick Opal, and the Atlantian College of Heralds, Greetings!



Artist note: the blazon was changed due to the rule “you can not have a charge issuing a from the edge of a fieldless badge”. When drawing please make an end on to the branch.




4. Helena Kassandreia - New Name

6. Þorgrímr kráka - New Badge

(Fieldless) A crow rising sable maintaining a hammer fesswise vert



7. Toth Eva Franciska - New Name

Note: In the original submission the name Tóth Eva Francesca had supporting documentation that was unusable due to time period and culture rules about naming. However a commenter came up with a documentable fully Hungarian culture name which the submitter approved during Kingdom review.

Returns:

1. Mordechai Honigbeine -New Name

This name must be return do to lack of documentation to support the last name. The documentation used from Hanks and Hodges dictionary of First names and Hanks and Hodges dictionary of Surnames is a source to be avoided per Administrative Handbook Appendix F. While additional supporting documentation was found for the first name, sadly none could be found for the Surname, (a constructed descriptive German byname meaning "honeylegs"). Suggestions were given included:

Honimeger-Honey-man (a honey seller/merchant) found German Names by Bahlow.

Or a locative Honigberg (literally "honey-hill" this is the German name of Hărman in Romania.

Also offered was the Late period English name Mordechai Honey Bee

Mordechai found in late period English records in family search.

Honey as a surname :Bynames Found in the 1523 Subsidy Roll for York and Ainsty, England" by Karen Larsdatter (<http://heraldry.sca.org/names/york16/bynamesalphabetically.htm>).

Bee as a surname: "Dictionary of Tudor London Names" by Aryanhwy merch Catmael

Mordechai Honey Bee is therefore a possible late-period English given name + double surname

2. Mordechai Honigbeine -New Device

Azure, a costrel, in chief two bees Or
